Within the **IPSP2024** Conference, two workshops and two technical tours will be organized for participants.

**WORKSHOP 1** "Interactive Workshop on Stored Grain Protection: Challenges, Innovations, and Industry Outlook by NovIGRain Research Project"

**WORKSHOP 2** "Biorational methods for stored seed pest control and protection: To serve and prevent by SafeSeed project"

**TECHNICAL TOUR 1.** A visit to Danubius company. Danubius is the market leader in Serbia in the sale of flour and pasta. It is considered that in Serbia, every third pastry or bread, pasta, or cake is made from products from Danubius. Danubius factory of flour, pasta, and bakery products was founded In the year 1976, and in 2006 it became a member of the Delta Corporation. The production was improved by reconstructing equipment in the silos, replacing all the equipment in the mill, and introducing the latest pasta production line. The production and packaging equipment are now automated with robotics. Throughout the years, Danubius has evolved, adapting to the changing times while preserving its time-honored values and commitment to providing high-quality products. Danubius impresses with its preserved tradition and widely renowned quality of milling products and pasta.

**TECHNICAL TOUR 2.** A visit to main processing facility and Distributive center of the Institute of Field and Vegetable Crops (IFVCNS). This facility is used for maize, soybean and cereal processing at IFVCNS, with a capacity of 10 tonnes per hour, equipped with new seed sorters, pesticide applicators and packaging equipment. Distributive center is a pallet storage center with capacity of 8000 tones (pallete places) distributed at four levels. It is equipped with an automated ventialtion and sensors for continious monitoring of temperature and humidity, and with one segment, a cold chamber, with controlled conditions (temperature 10-15 °C). It is designed for storaging of different seed commodities.


